I have taught languages for eleven years, five in London as a Spanish teacher and six in Navarra as an English teacher. I have a degree in Media Studies from the University of Navarra, where I mastered the basic techniques of written and oral communication. Learning English in London led to my gaining the CEELT

(Cambridge Examinations in English for Language Teachers) qualification, the Advanced English Language Diploma (C2) from the Official Language School of Spain, and the Diploma of Pedagogical Aptitude (Spanish teaching certificate).

In London I worked for a year in the private sector, teaching Business Spanish to adult students of varying levels of ability. I then spent four years teaching mostly Spanish in public high/secondary schools, although I also taught other subjects as a supply teacher.

In Navarra I worked as an English teacher for six years in various language academies, teaching primary and secondary schoolchildren and adults. These years developed personal qualities such as patience, determination and a sense of humor. I also learned effective prioritization and time management.
